Tag Gaelic Rules

Panel

- 7 players on the pitch at start of match
- Each team should have at least 2 girls on pitch at all times
- Panel of Maximum 12 with unlimited substitutes
- All players need to sign registration form at start of competition
- All players need to be born before 1 JANUARY 1995. There is no upper age limit !!
- Subs can go on at any part of pitch but are only active when both tags are on.
- Tag shorts or tag belts (provided) are allowed but players have to have jerseys tucked in at all times
- Tags need to be positioned on side of body rather than back/front

Scoring

- Guy goal = 3 points
- Girl goal = 4 points
- Guy point = 1 point
- Girl point = 2 points
- Can only fist points
- Goals can be fisted or kicked

Rules

- No physical contact allowed between players. Tagging a player replaces tackle.
- Usual rules apply to sideline balls, 45's (half way line), penalties.
- One tag = turnover of possession
- Tagger has to take turnover of possession
- Ball can be picked off ground
- Kick outs taken from the hand from the goal line.
- Size 4 ball to be used
- Game starts with following formation = 2 defenders, 2 midfielders, 2 forwards and 1 goalkeeper
- No square balls
- Once a player who touches a ball without both tags on, it will be automatic turnover of possession
- 7 minutes a side with 1 minute half time
- For each minute a team is late on pitch once referee blows whistle, they are deducted 3 points.
- If a team is 5 minutes late, the opposition is awarded a 15 nil victory.
- Complete Set of Rules will be available at registration desk on the day.

Discipline

- Yellow card and match sin bin for remainder of that game for verbal abuse of referees though player can be replaced.
- Match red card for physical contact.
- Serious foul play equates to tournament suspension.
